Called Zoom Vestry Meeting, December 29, 2021

ATTENDANCE:

OPENING PRAYER

Rev. Bill opened the meeting with prayer at 4:05PM.

Rev. Bill and Carl began the meeting by explaining that Carl would like to make a generous donation of \$98,000 to Redeemer with the intention of starting a housing ministry. Rev. Bill has spoken with the diocese, including Lang Lowery, about this, and has approval. It was agreed that Redeemer can start a committee as a first order of business in 2022, and explore the options. If this does not work out as planned, the funds can later be used in another capacity, such as the Capital Campaign. The original action will be the purchase of a condominium in The Crossroads At Lake Oconee, 107 Oak Grove Lane, Unit 2107, Eatonton, GA 31024. Les moved that we establish a housing ministry, seconded by Ed, and approved, with one no vote. Linda then moved that we receive the seed money, this was seconded by Mimi and approved, with one abstention. John moved that we purchase the condominium at 107 Oak Grove Lane, Unit 2107, Eatonton, Ga 31024, contingent on a satisfactory inspection report, seconded by Nancy, and approved with one abstention. John then moved that we set up a housing committee to organize and manage this program, seconded by Linda, and approved, with one abstention. Rev. Bill and the Senior Warden will be the signatories on the purchase of the Condominium. All thanked Carl for this very generous donation. He said that it was his pleasure and also volunteered to chair the new committee.

Rev. Bill closed the meeting at 5:30PM, and the group joined in The Lord's Prayer.
